



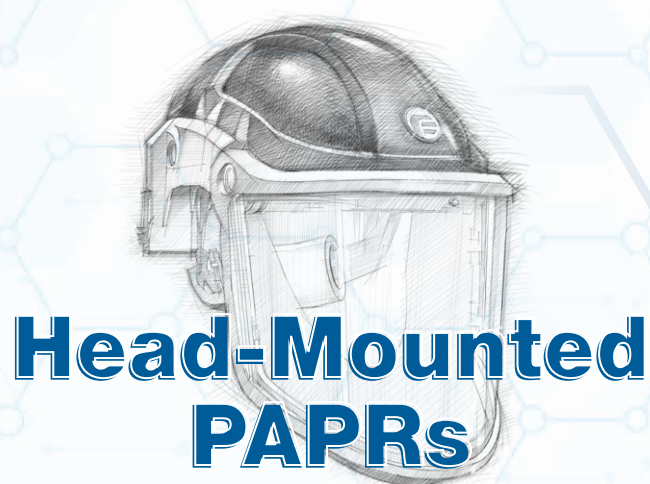

COST OF OWNERSHIP

- Head-mounted solution means fewer parts (SKUs) to inventory
- Fewer breakable components reduces need for additional replacement parts
- Entire system can be worn under disposable hood, protecting sensitive components from contamination and increasing user protection



SAFETY

- No belts or hose improves comfort and mobility, and reduces the risk of snagging on other medical equipment/objects
- Fewer parts reduces amount of equipment exposed to potential contamination issues



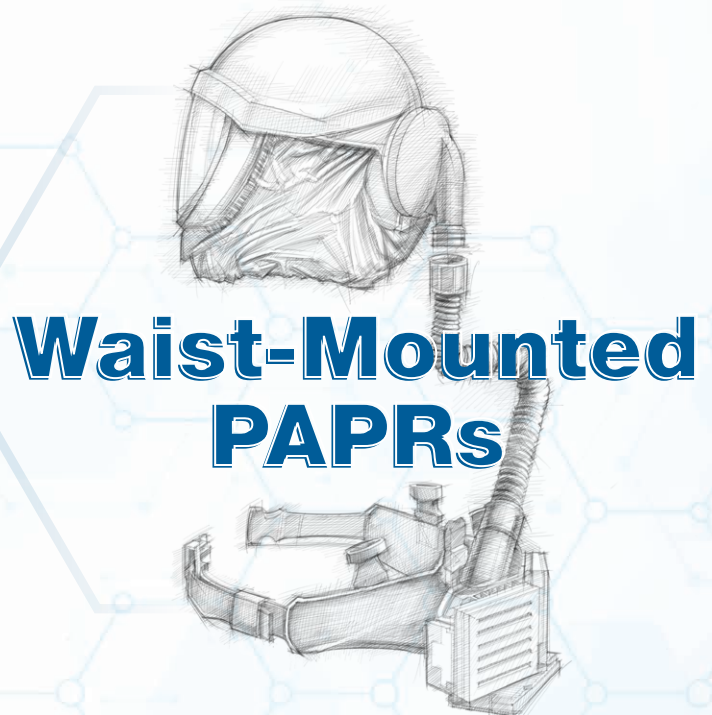
COMFORT AND USABILITY

- Head-mounted design provides greater mobility than waist-mounted PAPRs
- Integrated/balanced design improves user comfort



WORK EFFICIENCY AND EFFECTIVENESS

- Minimal setup: Can be used out of the box
- Fast and easy donning and doffing
- Easy to maintain and support due to fewer parts



Waist-Mounted PAPRs



COST OF OWNERSHIP

- More parts makes ordering more difficult, not ready to use out of the box
- More exposed parts means more potential points of failure and contamination issues



SAFETY

- Hoses and belts reduce mobility and present a greater risk of snagging on other medical equipment/objects



COMFORT AND USABILITY

- Hose and belt limit mobility in tight spaces
- Weight concentrated to lower back may lead to ergonomic distress



WORK EFFICIENCY AND EFFECTIVENESS

- More setup and assembly time due to more working parts
- More time required for donning/doffing
- Generally requires more maintenance and support
